

Physical development

Moves freely and with pleasure and confidence in a range of ways, such as slithering, shuffling, rolling, crawling, walking, running, jumping, skipping, sliding and hopping.

Activities

Continuous provision PE – moving like fireworks

Communication and language

Extends vocabulary, especially by grouping and naming, exploring the meaning and sounds of new words.

Responds to simple instructions.

Activities

Circle time - making a mind map of experiences.

Talking about fireworks sounds, sights, smells

Following instructions during a maths game.

Talking about remembrance day

Expressive arts and design

Begins to build a repertoire of songs and dances.

Explores the different sounds of instruments.

Chooses particular colours to use for a purpose.

Understands that different media can be combined to create new effects.

Activities

Bonfire Pictures -Fireworks Pictures chalk and sugar paper.

Making rockets - cardboard tubes and paper tubes, pipe cleaners, glitter.

Making firework cakes

Red glitter playdough

Learning new rhymes and songs.

Use musical instruments to make sounds of fireworks

PSED

Activities

Activities

Listening and recalling the Guy Fawkes story. (wk1)

Create class poem about fireworks - thinking of words to describe bonfire night and fireworks.

Reading a recipe. (wk2)
