Drinks - please make sure they only have water.

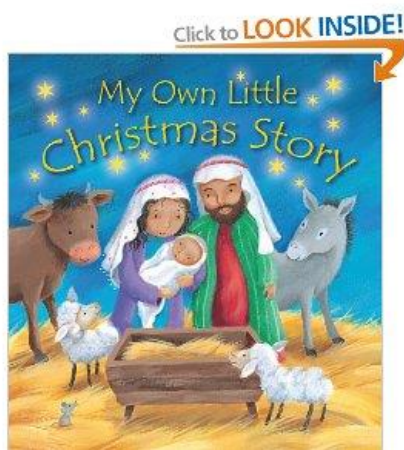
We will be learning . . .

In Maths - They will use the days of the week in context, e.g. through a story. They recognise a minute as unit of time and count actions carried out in a minute (less than 20). They recite numbers to 20, then 100.

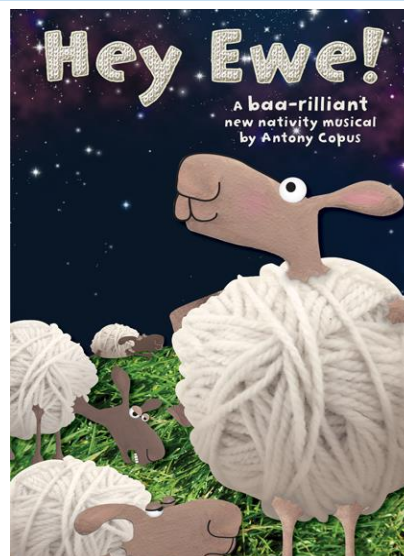
They can count back from at least 10 to zero. They can order numerals to at least 10 and count up to 20 objects. They begin to estimate quantities. They use ordinal numbers e.g. 1st, 2nd and 3rd.

In Literacy - They use some clearly identifiable letters to communicate meaning, representing some sounds correctly and in sequence. They look at books independently, handle them carefully, know information can be relayed in the form of print, hold books the correct way up and turn the pages, know that print carries meaning and, in English, is read from left to right and top to bottom.
