

Learning Powers

Throughout the school we use 'Learning powers'. We refer to these in assemblies, continuous play, carpet sessions and adult led learning. The characteristics of learning in the early years link with the learning powers.

The children in both Panda and Rhino class use the following learning powers everyday.

Super problem solvers -

The children explore the continuous provision and early years setting solving problems -making links choosing ways to do things.



Co-operation Cop -

Children learn to share and co-operate. It helps develop team work and helps them make long lasting friendships.

Reflective detectives-

Children enjoy finding out and exploring. They will seek out information and ways to improve on work.



Resilient Ranger-

Children are willing to have a go. They may make mistakes but they keep on trying.

Professor perseverance-

Children do not give up and they keep trying building resilience.



Captain curiosity-

Children are interested in the world and its surroundings. They investigate things that interest them
