
Welcome back! We hope you had a lovely half term break and are ready to start the lead up to Christmas.

## English

In English, we will continue to work on writing in full sentences remembering to include a capital letter, finger spaces, use our Freddy fingers to sound out words and full stops. We will also start to use more adjectives in our writing when describing characters or settings.

We will be writing many stories this half term, retelling famous stories and creating our own. We shall also be looking at writing instructions, letters and character descriptions. We will be using films and TV programs to support our writing like Alice in Wonderland and Mr Ben.



## Maths

In maths we will be continuing to solve addition and subtraction problems using Numicon, Base 10 and number lines. We will also be looking at how to solve division and multiplication problems using Numicon, Base 10 and number line. We will also be attempting to understand what is meant by the term 'inverse' in mathematics.



## Design & Technology

We will be designing our own biscuits to make us grow or shrink.



## Science

In science we will be looking at animals including humans. We will be looking at what animals need to survive and grow, looking at the life cycle of different animals and looking at the food chains of local animals.



## PE

We will be focusing on multiskills and using different equipment to improve these skills. These skills include: Kicking, throwing, running and jumping.



## RE

We will be focusing on Christianity and mainly looking at the celebration of Christmas and why Christians celebrate the holiday.

## Computing

We will be using the iPads and Stop motion apps to create our own fireworks display using Lego. We will also be using voice recorders and iPads to record and retell stories.

## History and Geography

We will be looking at the story of Guy Fawkes and why we celebrate on the 5<sup>th</sup> November. In Geography we will be looking at and naming all the different oceans and continents of the world.



## Art

We will be using lots of different art materials to create pictures and crafts to celebrate Guy Fawkes and Christmas. We shall also be looking at the artist Salvador Dali.

## Music

We will be learning lots of Christmas songs and using instruments to express feelings in films.
