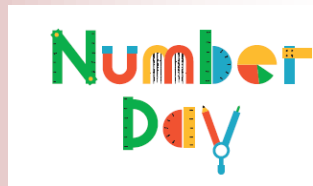
Covid Update

The self-isolation advice for people with coronavirus (COVID-19) has changed. It is now possible to end self-isolation after 5 full days if you have 2 negative LFD tests taken on consecutive days. If you test negative on Day 5 and Day 6, pupils can return to school on Day 6.

If, however, you test positive on Day 5 you need to remain isolated. You can retest on day 6, 7, 8 and 9. Once you have 2 consecutive negative tests you can stop isolating otherwise you will need to continue isolation for the full 10 days.

Please can we remind parents not to park on the zig-zag lines outside school when dropping off or collecting your child.

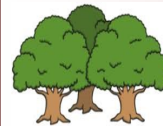
Children should be brought to the classroom door each morning and supervised before handing them over to a member of staff. The play equipment must not be used during this time.
