Last week we read the stories *Superhero Like You* and *What the Ladybird Heard at the Farm*. We talked about what we want to be when we grow up. We also discussed who is in our community and who helps us. We learnt the sounds i, n, p, g and o in phonics. In maths we explored sorting rules and found different ways to sort objects e.g. colour, shape and size.

This week we are learning about ...

Topic

Personal Social and Emotional Development

This week we will be learning about their bodies and the basic parts e.g. eyes, nose, ears. They will link this to their senses. They will also learn the importance of managing their own basic hygiene e.g. hand washing.

Communication and Language

We will be reading the story *I Don't Want to Wash My Hands*. This will be taught through Drawing Club which helps immerse the children into a world full of imagination where we will be bringing the story to life!

We will begin by drawing a princess with dirty hands. Then the magic happens the children add letters and numbers to their pictures to make 'something magical happen to their character'. These 'magical passcodes' help encourage them to write!



Exploring the body parts we use for senses
