### **English**



When writing we will think about time conjunctions and adjectives. We will then spend time looking at the book The Great Explorer. We will finish by making a comic strip about the book thinking about the characters thoughts and feelings. After this we will read the book Lost and found and use Talk for Writing techniques to retell the story with actions and write our own lost and found story. Before Christmas we will look at how Christmas is celebrated and the story of Christmas.
